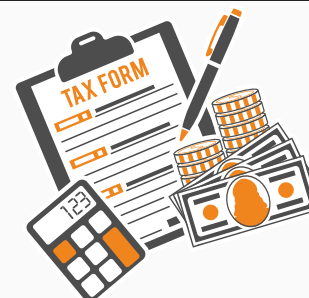

1098-WHO!? 1098-T

The 1098-T, tuition statement, is a tax form used to help figure education credits for qualified tuition and related expenses paid during the tax year. Student Financial Services provides 1098-Ts for the previous calendar year on, or before, January 31st. via electronic delivery on your Student Account Center. 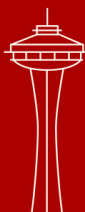

DID YOU KNOW?

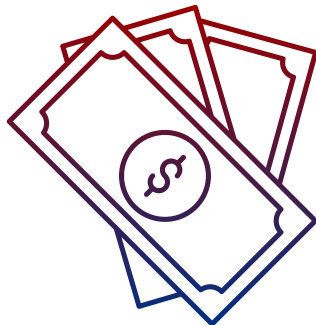
