Cardiac Vascular Track

A student must complete 180 credits and earn a major/program and cumulative GPA of 2.00 (C) or better in all courses taken at SU. All majors must obtain a minimum grade of C (2.00) in all DIUS courses. The Diagnostic Ultrasound program is a cohort format in which students must take all of the ultrasound courses in the prescribed order and with the group of students with whom they entered with. The ultrasound specific curriculum must be completed in 2 years.
