### PROGRAM OVERVIEW

The Sogang Exchange Program seeks to develop a cross-culturally competent, global perspective by providing a semester of transformative, experiential learning focused on an international perspective in the Korean context. 24 majors and 10 interdisciplinary programs are offered in its undergraduate program of 8,000 students. In addition to taking courses, students may have the opportunity to intern at a major multinational business such as Samsung Electronics, LG Electronics, and Hewlett-Packard during their length of stay.

### HOST ORGANIZATION

Sogang University was founded in 1960 by the Society of Jesus and is the only Jesuit higher educational institution in Korea. A little over 1,350 foreign students study year round at Sogang University. It is located in the heart of Seoul where students will be able to explore the city's nightlife, culture, and, of course, Korean food.
