Students educated to the age of 16 in schools outside the United States may use HIST 2310 as a substitute for HIST 1210. Students who place out of second year language must take 40 credits of INST major electives instead of 25 credits. INST Electives: Choose a total of 25 credits of approved electives as found in the Course Catalog and listed on the International Studies department website, in consultation with your academic advisor. At least 10 credits must be chosen from the humanities list and 10 credits from the social sciences list. 15 of the 25 elective credits must also be in courses with regional students (RS) designation, and at least 5 of these 15 regional studies credits must have a non-Western designation (RS-NW). Note that regional studies electives also meet the humanities and social science elective requirements. The International Studies Major requires a learning program in a country other than the United States. An acceptable study abroad experience for the International Studies major includes a minimum of 15 quarter credits, or its equivalent in semester credits, provided that the student meets full time status in the chosen study abroad program. <p>For complete information on courses, prerequisites, etc, use this information in conjunction with the online Catalog (http://catalog.seattleu.edu/) for the current year.</p>
