



JOB & INTERNSHIP SEARCH

STEP 1: PREPARE

- Meet with a Career Advisor in Albers Career Center
- Assess your interests, skills & goals
- Research employers/industries
- Develop a record keeping spreadsheet to track progress

STEP 2: SEARCH

- Utilize online resources (see page 2)
- Seek opportunities from professors, family, friends, classmates, & student orgs.
- Conduct Informational Interviews with people in the field or companies of interest
- Participate in On-Campus Recruiting
- Attend Company Information Sessions
- Attend Career and Job Fairs
- Review weekly job/internship email newsletter from ACC
- Search websites of desired companies

STEP 3: APPLY

- Prepare resume & cover letter
- Seek advice on application materials from Career Advisor or people in the industry
- Prepare a list of 3-4 references
- Submit application materials based on company instructions
- Track submitted applications on personal record keeping spreadsheet

STEP 4: FOLLOW UP

- Follow up with employers and network contacts
- Send thank you notes to people with whom you speak/meet
- Prep for interviewing
