

POST ACCESSIBLE PDF FILES

Marketing Communication only allows accessible PDF files in the Media Library.

If you want to link to a PDF in the Seattle University T4 Media Library, you'll need to ensure your PDF is accessible **before** you upload it to the Media Library. Adobe Acrobat Pro is an excellent program for testing PDF accessibility.

Do not upload Word, Excel, or other formats. Instead, export a PDF from these programs. Learn how to make your Microsoft documents accessible for export to PDF below.
